Toshi Richardson of Portsmouth, New Hampshire, is a personal trainer and commercial model. She was experiencing skin breakouts and desired a makeup that would be lightweight and not clog her pores. For this reason, mineral-based cosmetics were used for her foundation base.

- Step 1:** After cleansing the face, use fingers to apply a dry skin treatment cream to appropriate areas of the skin. Using the fingers again, apply an anti-shine serum to the T-zone and blend.
- Step 2:** Use a disposable lip brush to apply lip balm to the lips.
- Step 3:** With a small, synthetic camouflage brush, apply a mineral-based concealer under the eyes and on the upper inner corner of the eye.
- Step 4:** Use a flat Kabuki-style brush to apply a yellow-based pressed mineral base all over the face, including the eye area.
- Step 5:** Fill in the eyebrow area with a dark taupe eyebrow pencil. Use a small, angled eyebrow brush to fill the area in again with a dark brown eyebrow powder.
- Step 6:** Apply a matte deep caramel tone eye shadow all over the eyelid using a small chisel eye shadow brush. Apply a blackberry eye shadow in the crease of the eye using a small pointed crease brush.
- Step 7:** Apply a thin line of black eye liner very lightly to the center of the upper eyelids, but don't fully extend either way.
- Step 8:** Use a small fan brush to apply black cake mascara. This was used instead of a thicker formula on the very naturally curly lashes.
- Step 9:** Use an angled blush brush to apply a mocha-toned powder blush to the cheek area.
- Step 10:** Apply a sheer but deep color of maroon high shine gloss to the lips using a flat sable lip brush. No lip liner was used.
- Step 11:** Lightly apply loose mineral powder all over the face using a large powder brush. ■
